ABOUT THE PLAYWRIGHT



Matthew Lombardo is a New York-based playwright whose work has been critically acclaimed and has earned him international recognition. Mr. Lombardo's Broadway credits include *High* starring Kathleen Turner at the Booth Theatre, and *Looped* which featured Valerie Harper as Tallulah Bankhead in a Tony-nominated performance at The Lyceum Theatre.

Off-Broadway he has penned *Who's Holiday*, the irreverent comedy showcasing the talent of Lesli Margherita as an adult Cindy Lou Who at the Westside Theatre (Lucille Award Nomination for Outstanding Solo Show); *Tea At Five* which starred Kate Mulgrew as Katharine Hepburn at the Promenade Theatre (IRNE Award winner for Best Solo Play); *Mother and Child* featuring Tony Award-winning actress Ann Wedgeworth at Second Stage; and *Guilty Innocence* at The Actors' Playhouse.

His plays have received three National Tours including *High*, again with Ms. Turner; *Looped*, which starred Stefanie Powers; and *Tea at Five* which featured the talents of Faye Dunaway, Stephanie Zimbalist and Tovah Feldshuh.

Internationally, his plays have been translated into several languages and have been performed all over the world.

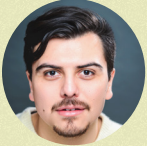

Alec is a Queer, mixed-race, Latiné performer, multi-hyphenate artist, and 2016 graduate of Pacific University excited to be returning to Bag&Baggage in *Who's Holiday!* This production is a special homecoming for Alec, as the last time they were seen onstage with Bag&Baggage was in 2015's *Rope* (as Sabot), where they made their professional career stage debut. Select theatrical credits include: Portland Center Stage (*tick, tick ... BOOM!*); Profile Theatre (*The Elaborate Entrance of Chad Deity*); Fuse Theatre Ensemble (*The Pursuit of Happiness, Our Town*); Portland Playhouse (*Great Wide Open, Matilda: The Musical*); and Anonymous Theatre (*The Pirates of Penzance*); among others. Radio and television credits include work with All Classical Portland, Oregon Public Broadcasting's "*All Science. No Fiction.*", and IFC's Emmy-nominated *Documentary Now!* episode "Original Cast Recording: Cop-op." Alec serves as the Marketing & Events Manager with the Portland Gay Men's Chorus, and his work in photography, videography, and graphic design has been featured locally and nationally. Alec was also previously employed as the Marketing Manager with Bag&Baggage, and was responsible for the company's rebranding and logo design currently in use today. Mandy studied literature, theater, and history (and improvisation) at Stanford University, where she earned a B.A. and M.A. in English. Past B&B appearances onstage include *Romeo & Juliet/Layla & Majnun* (Lady Capulet), *Death and the Maiden* (Paulina), *Deathtrap* (Helga), *Much Ado About Nothing* (Margaret/Dogberry), and the one-person *I F*cking Hate Shakespeare*. At B&B she also designed the set for *Red Velvet*, the projections for *The Last White Man*, the costumes for *Complete Works (Abridged)*, and the choreography/fights for *A Clockwork Orange*. At other theaters in town, she's recently been in such shows as *The Rocky Horror Show* (Eddie/Dr. Scott); *Die Hard: The Musical Parody* (Mother Gruber/Inga); and *Back to the Future: The Musical Parody* (Biff). Design work elsewhere includes lights for *Adam's Run* (Renegade Opera), and costumes for *Body Awareness* (Twilight Theatre); and *Golden Girls: LIVE and Heathers, the Musical* (Funhouse Lounge). She's also a director and theater educator; recent favorite projects include several bilingual shows for Milagro Theatre, and *Triassic Park: the Musical* at the Funhouse Lounge. Recently, she published her first book, *Managed Mischief*, about improvisation and creativity. At home, a place she sometimes has time to go, she maintains an excess of books, art supplies, and impractical musical instruments.

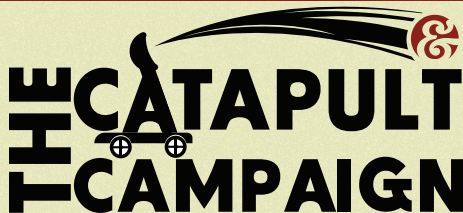

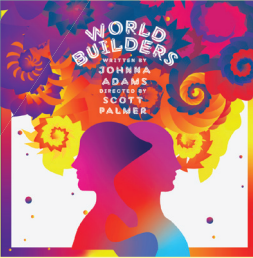

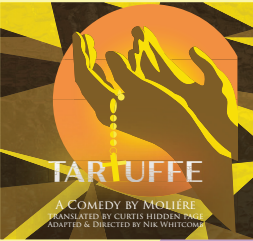
